KAAF University College is affiliated to the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology and is the first private university in Ghana accredited by the National Accreditation Board to run degree programmes in Civil Engineering, Geomatic (Geodetic) Engineering and Construction Technology. In addition, programmes are offered leading to the Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Administration. The main campus is located at Buduburam (near Kasoa) in the Central Region.

KAAF University College is admitting students for September 2011 into the following programmes:

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

BSc Civil Engineering

Candidates applying to the programme must meet the following entry requirements:

SSSCE/ WASSCE Holders

Credit scores of **grade D for SSSCE** and **grade C6 for WASSCE** or better in the following subjects: English Language, Integrated Science, Core Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Elective Mathematics.

Mature Applicants

Applicants in this category must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be at least 25 years old at the time of submitting application;
2. Must have a minimum of three (3) years relevant experience;
3. Must have credit scores in English Language, Physics, Chemistry, Additional Mathematics or Elective Mathematics; and,
4. Must pass an entrance examination or an interview.

GCE 'A' LEVEL Holders

Must have GCE 'A' LEVEL passes in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics;

Top-up for HND Holders

Candidates who hold HND certificates in Civil Engineering and have a minimum of two (2) years relevant experience may be admitted to Level 300 as regular students. To be admitted to level 300, students will take one semester bridging course. However, advancement to level 300 will be based on satisfactory performance of the bridging course.

Those whose work or business schedule cannot allow them to attend as regular students may opt for the non-regular student module. For such students, evening and/or weekend classes will be conducted on our Accra campus or our main campus.

BSc Geomatic (Geodetic) Engineering

Candidates applying to the programme must meet the following entry requirements:

SSSCE/ WASSCE Holders

Credit scores of **grade D for SSSCE** and **grade C6 for WASSCE** or better in the following subjects: English Language, Integrated Science, Core Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Elective Mathematics.

Mature Applicants

Applicants in this category must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be at least 25 years old at the time of submitting application;
2. Must have a minimum of three (3) years relevant experience;
3. Must have credit scores in English Language, Physics, Chemistry, Additional Mathematics or Elective Mathematics; and,
4. Must pass an entrance examination or an interview.

GCE 'A' LEVEL Holders

Must have GCE 'A' LEVEL passes in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics;

Top-up for HND Holders

Candidates who hold HND certificates in Surveying and have a minimum of two (2) years relevant experience may be admitted to Level 300 as regular students. To be admitted to level 300, students will take one semester bridging course. However, advancement to level 300 will be based on satisfactory performance of the bridging course.

Those whose work or business schedule cannot allow them to attend as regular students may opt for the non-regular student module. For such students, evening and/or weekend classes will be conducted on our Accra campus.

BSc Construction Technology

Candidates applying to the programme must meet the following entry requirements:

SSSCE/ WASSCE Holders

1. Credit scores **grade D for SSSCE** and **grade C6 for WASSCE** or better in the following core subjects: English Language, Integrated Science, Mathematics, and;
2. Credit scores (aggregate D) or better in either,
 - Physics, Chemistry and Elective Mathematics; OR,
 - Economics, Geography and Elective Mathematics; OR
 - Technical Drawing, Building Construction and Elective Mathematics.

Mature Applicants

Applicants in this category must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be at least 25 years old at the time of submitting application;
2. Must have a minimum of three (3) years relevant experience;
3. Must have credit scores in English Language, plus
 - Physics, Chemistry and Elective Mathematics; OR,
 - Economics, Geography and Elective Mathematics; OR
 - Technical Drawing, Building Construction and Elective Mathematics; and,
4. Must pass an entrance examination or an interview.

GCE 'A' LEVEL Holders

Must have GCE 'A' LEVEL passes in either

- Physics, Chemistry and Mathematic; OR,
- Economics, Geography and Elective Mathematics.

Construction Technician Certificate (CTC II /III)

Applicants in this category with a minimum of three (3) years relevant experience will be placed at Level 300 of the programme as full-time students. To be admitted to level 300, students will take one semester bridging course. However, advancement to level 300 will be based on satisfactory performance of the bridging course.

Those whose work or business schedule cannot allow them to attend as regular students may opt for the non-regular student module. For such students, evening and/or weekend classes will be conducted on our Accra campus or our main campus.

Top-up for HND Holders

Candidates who hold HND certificates in Building Technology and have a minimum of two (2) years relevant experience may be admitted to Level 300 as regular students. To be admitted to level 300, students will take one semester bridging course. However, advancement to level 300 will be based on satisfactory performance of the bridging course.

Those whose work or business schedule cannot allow them to attend as regular students may opt for the non-regular student module. For such students, evening and/or weekend classes will be conducted on our Accra campus.

Candidates applying to the Bachelor of Arts programmes in Business Administration must meet the following entry requirements:

SSSCE WASSSCE / Holder

Credit scores of **grade D for SSSCE** and **grade C6 for WASSCE** or better in English Language, Integrated Science, Core Mathematics, and in any three (3) elective subjects.

Mature Applicants

Applicants in this category must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be at least 25 years old at the time of submitting application;
2. Must have a minimum of three (3) years relevant experience; and
3. Must pass an entrance examination or an interview.

Other (Mature) Candidates

Candidates with the following certificates will also be considered for KAAF BBA programmes: ACCA Level 1; CA (Gh.) Part 1; CIM Professional Certificate; CIPS Certificate; RSA Stage III (3 passes). Such candidates will be considered to register for Level 200 programme after an interview.

GCE 'A' LEVEL Holders

Must have GCE 'A' LEVEL passes in any three subjects.

Cert 'A' Holders (Post-sec)

Cert 'A' holders with a minimum of two (2) years experience will be placed at Level 200 of the programme.

DBS (Diploma in Business Studies) Holders

DBS graduates with a minimum of two (2) years relevant experience will be placed at Level 200 (Year 2) of the programme. Applicants must also have passes in English Language and Mathematics at GCE "O" Level or WASSCE/SSSCE.

Top-up for HND Holders

Candidates who hold HND certificates in any discipline in Business Administration and have a minimum of two (2) years relevant experience may be admitted to Level 300 as regular students. Those whose work or business schedule cannot allow them to attend as regular students may opt for the non-regular student module. For such students, evening and/or weekend classes will be conducted on our Accra campus or our main campus.

Evening and Weekend Lectures

Evening and Weekend Lectures for all programmes are conducted on our main and Accra Lecture Halls for workers whose schedules do not permit them to be regular students. Evening lectures for all programmes start from 5:30pm and close at 9:00pm. Monday – Friday.
